## The Covid Bit

**COVID is still around and increasing in places, but with care and the following precautions, it should not affect our time at Clumberfest**

**You MUST NOT attend if you have tested positive for Covid OR are required to self isolate OR are feeling unwell**

We will provide sanitiser and disinfectant wipes and request that they are used regularly, as and when needed.

Mask wearing is not compulsory, but please feel free to use them if you feel more comfortable.

The portaloo toilets will be cleaned regularly and hand sanitiser will be provided for use when entering/exiting the portaloo. We will also provide disinfectant wipes/sanitiser for all communally touched areas - taps/waste drain etc please ensure you use them.

## The Kennel Cough Bit

Please do not attend if your dog is coughing or has been coughing and is still in the infectious period.

Previous visitors please note the entrance has changed!

Take the entrance as shown and stay to the left, at the top of the road turn right past the storage on your left and the house on your right then take the left up the track as usual.





# Travelling via M4 Eastbound or Westbound;

Leave the M4 at Junction 17 (Chippenham) then follow the A350 until you reach a roundabout between Melksham and Trowbridge where the A350 crosses the A361.

Take the third exit (signed A361 Trowbridge/Hilperton), follow that road past the crematorium, straight over the next roundabout and then approximately ½ mile further on where the bus stops are, turn right into the site. Signposted Fairfields.

New Entrance marked with red arrow in below picture. We will also have the Clumberfest signs out



# Travelling via M5 North/South

Join the M4 at Junction 15 head M4 east and then travel to Junction 17 (then see above)

# M5 North

Leave the M5 at Junction 23 then follow A39 to Street, A361 to Shepton Mallet, (A37 around Shepton Mallet) then A361 to Trowbridge, go through Trowbridge towards Melksham on the A361. When you go past Trowbridge Rugby Club on your left the site entrance is approximately ½ mile on your left by the bus stops. Signposted “Fairfields”. There will be signs to the Clumberfest paddock from there.



## Getting There

When in Fairfields!



Take the driveway to the left of the shed, over the cattle grid and stay left the follow the Clumberfest signs to the right past the farm house

## **Camping at Clumberfest**

There is plenty of space on a large 4 acre, secure, field. Caravans, Motorhomes & Tents of all sizes are all welcome.

Arrivals after 12 noon on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2022 and Departure before 12.00 on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2022.

It is preferred if you don't arrive after 9pm or before 8am. If this is needed please contact Peter to arrange.

Peter or Jackie will be on site to welcome you when you arrive any issues with finding us which I'm sure there won't be, the mobile number for Peter is 07971 590205 or Jackie on 01225 753960 on the Thursday only. Peter will also be there to make sure you leave on Monday!

Camping costs £12 a night but this is all inclusive of awnings, windbreaks, dogs etc (no hidden charges). Please pay for camping when you arrive.

There is fresh water available and foul waste disposal, sorry there is no electric hook up or on site showers.

We have arranged for portaloos to be on the camp site from Thursday – we do ask where possible if you have your own facilities please use them so that the portaloos are left for people in tents & day trippers

Generators are fine and there is a provision to charge batteries if needed. Please be considerate of other campers and do not use these late at night or early morning.

We will set up gazebos in the field to give shelter, if you would like to bring your own to add to the shelter collection that would be great.

*Previous campers - Sorry we do not have access to the kitchen/hut this year. We may be able to use a fridge/freezer but this cannot be confirmed until we are on site.*

## **Facilities**

### **Toilets**

We have rented 2 portaloos which will be on site from Thursday.

There will be sanitiser at the toilets and we ask that it is used before and after using. We will also clean regularly.

To limit potential germ spreading, if you have facilities in your van, please use them and empty them at the foul waste point provided.

There will be one portaloos in the field that has been hired by a specific camper for their personal use. It will be marked. Please do not use this portaloos (unless you are that specific camper).

### **Waste**

#### **The Messy but Essential Information**

Waste – Recycling and Landfill

There will be bins provided for waste – please ensure you follow the signage and correctly sort your waste.

There will be separate bins for dog waste. Please DO NOT put dog waste into the general waste, it must be kept separate.

### **Clean Water and Waste Water**

At the campsite there is a potable water supply and place to dispose of the foul waste.

#### **Clean Water**

There is a tap on the outside of the building to the left of the door at the opposite corner. Please ensure the tap is turned off when you have finished.

#### **Grey Water**

There is no specific place to dispose of grey water, feel free to water the grass under your outfit (if feasible) or tip it in the hedgerow.

#### **Foul Waste**

To the left of the tap near the field gate is a rectangular drain cover. Please lift that and empty your foul waste into there, can you make sure wash it down afterwards (to help avoid the drain clogging).

DO NOT use the hose pipe directly from the fresh water to rinse out foul waste.

### **Shelters**

We will have 2 gazebos set up .

We have plenty of room so if you would like to bring your own gazebos please feel free to. We do not have any chairs, you will need to bring your own.



## **Drinking (Non-Alcoholic and Alcoholic)**

If you fancy a trip out – we have Lilleys Cider at Frome (only about 15 miles away) with an impressive range of ciders and available in bottles and boxes and on your way back why not visit Still Sisters who have a large range of gins and gin liqueurs.

Or if you're a beer person we have Box Steam Brewery (only 6.5 miles away) - who have donated to the raffle—that have a lovely selection of locally brewed and very tasty beers! The bottled beers are even Gluten Free!

## **Eating and Drinking**

If you just fancy a walk, there is a pub that does good “pub grub” a short walk away and you can have the Clumbers in the “beer garden” in the nearby village of Semington.

The Somerset Arms in Semington is a very popular local with food, drink and within easy walking distance of the site via a path over the fields, and access to the canal not far from there. Of course you can also drive to it. They have an outside area and dogs are welcome!

They strongly advise pre booking tables for a visit as they are very popular – 01380 870067

To drive, the postcode is – BA14 6JR, or to walk - it is just a short walk from the site, just ask Peter for directions!
