The Covid Bit

COVID is still around and increasing in places, but with care and the following precautions, it should not affect our time at Clumberfest

You MUST NOT attend if you have tested positive for Covid OR are required to self isolate OR are feeling unwell

We will provide sanitiser and disinfectant wipes and request that they are used regularly, as and when needed. Mask wearing is not compulsory, but please feel free to use them if you feel more comfortable.

The portaloo toilets will be cleaned regularly and hand sanitiser will be provided for use when entering/exiting the portaloo.

The Kennel Cough Bit

We are aware of a recent upsurge in Kennel Cough in some areas in recent weeks. Please do not attend if your dog is coughing or has been coughing and is still in the infectious period.

Previous visitors please note the entrance has changed!

Take the entrance as shown and stay to the left, at the top of the road turn right past the storage on your left and the house on your right then take the left up the track as usual.



Travelling via M4 Eastbound or Westbound;

Leave the M4 at Junction 17 (Chippenham) then follow the A350 until you reach a roundabout between Melksham and Trowbridge where the A350 crosses the A361.

Take the third exit (signed A361 Trowbridge/Hilperton), follow that road past the crematorium, straight over the next roundabout and then approximately ½ mile further on where the bus stops are, turn right into the site. Signposted Fairfields.

New Entrance marked with red arrow in below picture. We will also have the Clumberfest signs out



Travelling via M5 North/South

Join the M4 at Junction 15 head M4 east and then travel to Junction 17 (then see above)

M5 North

Leave the M5 at Junction 23 then follow A39 to Street, A361 to Shepton Mallet, (A37 around Shepton Mallet) then A361 to Trowbridge, go through Trowbridge towards Melksham on the A361. When you go past Trowbridge Rugby Club on your left the site entrance is approximately ½ mile on your left by the bus stops. Signposted "Fairfields". There will be signs to the Clumberfest paddock from there.

Take the driveway to the left of the shed, over the cattle grid and stay left the follow the Clumberfest signs to the right past the farm house

Toilets

We have rented 2 portaloos which will be on site.

There will be sanitiser at the toilets and it ist here for your use. We will also clean the toilets regularly.

There will be one portaloo in the field that has been hired by a specific camper for their personal use. It will be signed. Please do not use this portaloo (unless you are that specific camper).

There is fresh water available on site - really sorry we have no refreshments available this year.

(I'm sure if you ask a camper nicely, they will make you a cuppa!)

Shelters

We will have a gazebo area set up, this is where we generally congregate.

We have plenty of room so if you would like to bring your own gazebos please feel free to. We do not have any chairs, you will need to bring your own (there may be some spare or not used, so it won't be a major issue!).

Drinking (Non-Alcoholic and Alcoholic)

The kitchen has been stripped of its water and sink, so sorry we cannot offer any teas and coffees!

If you ask nicely I am sure a camper will be happy to boil water for you for teas and coffee's etc (ask Peter or Jackie) but please bring or have delivered to site any food & drink you need/want. We can store milk etc in a fridge for you.

Eating and Drinking

If you just fancy a walk, there is a pub that does good "pub grub" a short walk away and you can have the Clumbers in the "beer garden" in the nearby village of Semington.

The Somerset Arms in Semington is a very popular local with food, drink and within easy walking distance of the site via a path over the fields, and access to the canal not far from there. Of course you can also drive to it. They have an outside area and dogs are welcome there!

They strongly advise pre booking tables for a visit as the numbers they are allowed are severely limited at the $moment-01380\,870067$

To drive, the postcode is – BA14 6JR, or to walk - it is just a short walk from the site, just ask Peter for directions!


