# Welcome to Clumberfest 2026!

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## Kennel Cough

Please do not attend if your dog is coughing or has been coughing and is still in the infectious period.



Take the entrance as shown and stay to the left, at the top of the road turn right past the storage on your left and the house on your right then take the left up the track as usual.

# Travelling via M4 Eastbound or Westbound;

Leave the M4 at Junction 17 (Chippenham) then follow the A350 until you reach a roundabout between Melksham and Trowbridge where the A350 crosses the A361.

Take the third exit (signed A361 Trowbridge/Hilperton), follow that road past the crematorium, straight over the next roundabout and then approximately ½ mile further on where the bus stops are, turn right into the site. Signposted Fairfields.

New Entrance marked with red arrow in below picture. We will also have the Clumberfest signs out



# Travelling via M5 North/South

Join the M4 at Junction 15 head M4 east and then travel to Junction 17 (then see above)



# M5 North

Leave the M5 at Junction 23 then follow A39 to Street, A361 to Shepton Mallet, (A37 around Shepton Mallet) then A361 to Trowbridge, go through Trowbridge towards Melksham on the A361. When you go past Trowbridge Rugby Club on your left the site entrance is approximately ½ mile on your left by the bus stops. Signposted “Fairfields”. There will be signs to the Clumberfest paddock from there.



## Getting There

When in Fairfields!



Take the driveway to the left of the shed, over the cattle grid and stay left the follow the Clumberfest signs to the right past the farm house

## **Camping at Clumberfest**

There is plenty of space on a large 4 acre, secure, field. Caravans, Motorhomes & Tents of all sizes are all welcome.

**HOWEVER—If everyone turns up, we have the most campers we've had before at Clumberfest and whilst there is plenty of room, we need to be careful how/where people are sited—so please stop and speak to either Peter or Jackie before you start setting up (We will be the first caravan on the left as you enter the site—and if I've got my act together a sign saying "Peter & Jackie"!)**

Arrivals after 12 noon on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> July 2026 and Departure before 12.00 on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2026.

It is preferred if you don't arrive after 9pm or before 8am. If this is needed please contact Peter to arrange.

Peter or Jackie will be on site to welcome you when you arrive. If there are any issues with finding us (which I'm sure there won't be) the mobile number for Peter is 07971 590205 or you can call Jackie on 01225 753960 before the Thursday. Peter will also be there to make sure you leave on Monday!

Camping costs £15 a night but this is all inclusive of awnings, windbreaks, dogs etc (no hidden charges). Please pay for camping before you leave!

There is fresh water available and foul waste disposal. There is limited electric hook up (in quantity and current—battery charging and fridge/freezer only) There are no on site showers (but there are toilets – see below)

***We have arranged for a portaloo to be on the camp site from Thursday – we do ask where possible if you have your own facilities please use them so that the portaloo is left for people in tents & day trippers***

Generators are fine and there is a provision to charge batteries if needed. Please be considerate of other campers and do not use these late at night or early morning. I have one can borrow, just add petrol!

## **Facilities**

### **Toilets**

We have rented a portaloos which will be on site from Thursday. There are also 2 portaloos rented privately. We will clean the public one regularly.

To limit potential germ spreading and to leave the portaloos available for the day visitors and tent users, if you have facilities in your van, please use them and empty them at the foul waste point provided.

There will be two portaloos in the field that has been hired by specific campers for their personal use. It will be marked. Please do not use these portaloos (unless you are that specific camper).

### **Waste**

#### **The Messy but Essential Information**

Waste – Recycling and Landfill

There will be bins provided for waste – please ensure you follow the signage and correctly sort your waste.

There will be separate bins for dog waste. Please DO NOT put dog waste into the general waste, it must be kept separate.

### **Clean Water and Waste Water**

At the campsite there is a potable water supply and place to dispose of the foul waste.

#### **Clean Water**

There is a tap on the outside of the building to the left of the door at the opposite corner. Please ensure the tap is turned off when you have finished.

#### **Grey Water**

There is no specific place to dispose of grey water, feel free to water the grass under your outfit (if feasible) or tip it in the hedgerow.

#### **Foul Waste**

To the left of the tap near the field gate is a rectangular drain cover. Please lift that and empty your foul waste into there, can you make sure wash it down afterwards (to help avoid the drain clogging).

DO NOT use the hose pipe directly from the fresh water to rinse out foul waste.

### **Shelters**

We will have a number of event shelters set up .



## **Drinking (Non-Alcoholic and Alcoholic)**

If you fancy a trip out – we have Lilleys Cider at Frome (only about 15 miles away) with an impressive range of ciders and available in bottles and boxes and on your way back why not visit Still Sisters in Trowbridge who have a large range of gins and gin liqueurs.

## **Eating and Drinking**

Unfortunately the Somerset Arms in Semington is still closed—that was the only pub within walking distance! The other pub that was a short drive away “The Lamb on the Strand” 99 The Strand, Semington, Trowbridge BA14 6LL— is now an Italian Restaurant. I haven’t been there, but the reviews look OK.

## **Takeaways**

Both Just Eat & Deliveroo operate in our area.
